



STUDENT DRESS POLICY

2009-2010

Student Dress Policy

- All articles of student dress must be appropriately sized to the student and worn properly.
- Clothing must not be excessively loose or tight.
- Students may not add to, nor subtract from, the approved student dress policy.
- Student clothing must be maintained in good condition, without holes, rips or tears, or additions.

PANTS

Permitted...

- Solid color, clean, well-maintained
- May wear jeans
- Secured at the waist



NOT Permitted...

- cargo pants
- excessively baggy or tight pants
- fatigues, sweat pants, wind pants



SKIRTS / SKORTS

Permitted...

- Clean, well-maintained
- Solids, stripes, plaids and patterns
- Ankle length to 2" above the knee



Skirts and skorts may be worn by female students ONLY

SHORTS

Permitted...

- Solids, stripes, plaids and patterns
- Clean, well-maintained
- Formal/Dress style
- Secured at the waist



NOT Permitted...

- gym shorts, spandex or the like
- shorter than 2" above the knee



CAPRIS

Permitted...

- Solid color, clean, well-maintained
- May include jeans
- Secured at the waist



* Capris may be worn by female students ONLY*

SHIRTS

Permitted...

- Collared, button-down, dress or golf-style
- Solids, stripes, plaids and patterns
- Long sleeve or short sleeve
- Lackawanna Trail or approved affiliated logos



NOT Permitted...

- more than 2 buttons unbuttoned at the throat
- Manufacturer's logos no larger than 3" x 3"
- self-made, manufactured or constructed logos
- bare or exposed midriffs

* Shirts underneath must be solid with no visible writing *

SWEATERS

Permitted...

- Clean, well-maintained
- Solids, stripes, plaids, and patterns
- Crew neck, turtleneck, v-neck
- Cardigan sweater or sweater vest



- A collared shirt (in accordance with policy) or solid color turtleneck **MUST** be worn underneath the sweater *

SWEATSHIRTS

Permitted...

- Solid color, clean, well-maintained
- Crewneck sweatshirts



NOT Permitted...

- Hooded sweatshirts



* A collared shirt (in accordance with policy) or solid color turtleneck
MUST be worn underneath the sweatshirt *

SHOES

Permitted...

- Dress shoes or sneakers
- Socks must be worn



- * Solid color tights or nylons may be worn by females students *



NOT Permitted...

- Flip-flops or other beach shoes
- unsafe footwear
- shoes with wheels



OTHER



NOT Permitted...

- Sunglasses
- Jackets or other outerwear
- Head-coverings
- Bandanas



FORMAL CLOTHES

* Students may wear clothes of a more formal nature *



Boys: Men's or boy's suits or sport coats with solid color pants, dress shoes, dress shirt and tie

Girls: Women's or girl's dresses or suits



* Formal clothes must conform with all other aspects of the dress policy*
