Revised Wellness Center Floor Plan

- Mr. Ross made an opening statement addressing the process to date and the rumors on social media versus the reality of the Committees work.
- The Committee and any public in attendance were then invited on a tour of the current Athletic and Physical Education facilities.
- The Committee discussed the floor plan presented made by HC Architects at the January 5, 2023 meeting.
- Small alterations were discussed by the Committee. The Committee recommended in a 3-1 decision with Mrs. We scott dissenting to recommend that the project continue with the revised floor plan as presented by HC Architects to the 50% design phase for estimation.

Playground Update

 District is still waiting on a grant update from Wyoming County. The Committee set a timeline of April 1st where the district will either have an update on the grant or move towards a self-funded replacement.

Window Replacement Update

 District administration met with a potential corporate donor for window replacements at the High School. The district discussed the need and processes necessary for the approaching window replacement. A budget has not been set to this project due to the potential donation and the early point of discussion with this project.
